**Antonio di Capizzi.** Name.

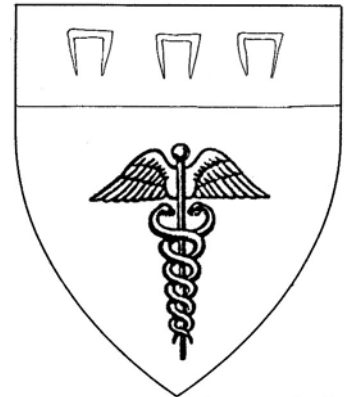

The Laurel Office in registering your name change ruled that Sergeants is not a suitable term for a household or order name because it does not unambiguously denote “a single body or collective which acts with a singular purpose”. Since they also felt that the term Sergeants is “fine as a descriptive element”, they simply inserted it between the former collective of Company and the saint’s name.

**Emma Barfoot.** Name.

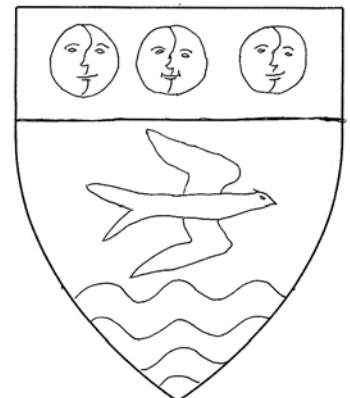
**Etain of Sutherland.** Name.

**James Sutherland of Inverness.** Device. Argent, a caduceus sable and on a chief azure three staples argent.



**Katherine O’Carroll.** Device. Azure, a bird volant to sinister argent and in base a ford proper, on a chief argent three moons in their plenitude azure.

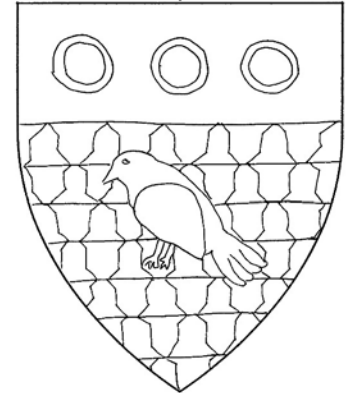


**Lora Moore.** Name and device. Per bend sinister sable and azure, in bend two lightning bolts bendwise sinister argent.

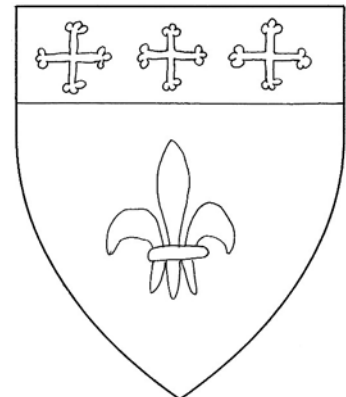


**Magdalena Ilianova.** Device. Vair, a magpie sable and on a chief gules three annulets Or.

**Marlein Magdalena Weber von Rothenburg.** Name.



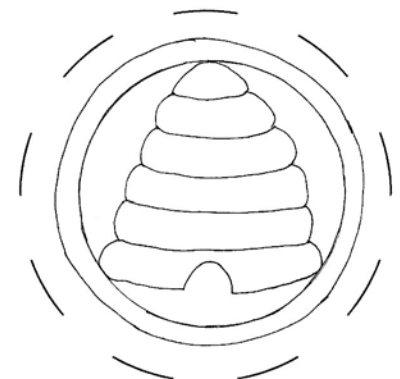
**Melisent la Ruse.** Device. Vert, a fleur-de-lys Or and on a chief argent three crosses bottony sable.



**Raphael de la Rosa.** Name and badge. (Fieldless) A scythe bendwise and overall a skull argent.

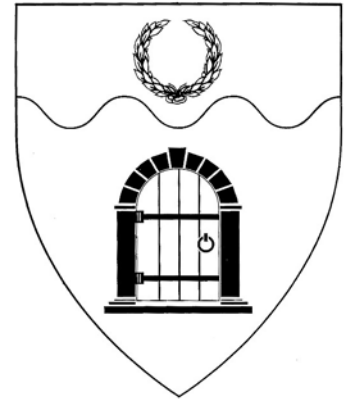


**Robert Pine.** Household name and badge for House Beehive. (Fieldless) A beehive within and conjoined to an annulet argent.



**Canton of Sudentorre.** Device. Argent, a wooden door proper within and conjoined to an arch sable masoned argent, on a chief wavy azure a laurel wreath argent.

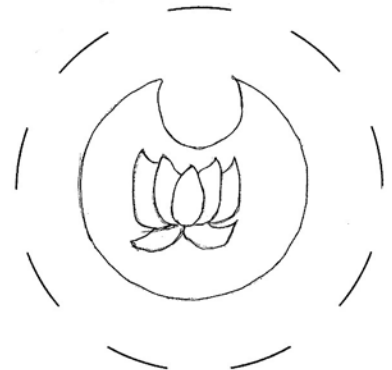
**Vittorio Mezzadri.** Name.



**RETURNS:**

The following items were RETURNED by the Laurel Office:

**Bessenyei Rossa.** Badge. (Fieldless) On a crescent sable a lotus blossom in profile argent. Her name was registered in February, 2004, at the same time as her device (“Vert, an orle of lotus blossoms in profile argent.”) The Laurel Office returned your badge for redrawing because they felt that the crescent was too fat for identifiability and the lotus in profile was not identifiable as such.



**Lidia de Ragusa.** Device. Per bend sinister bevilled azure and argent, a sun in splendor Or and a fox passant azure. Unfortunately, the Laurel Office deemed that the bevilled line of division has to have the bottom portion of the bevilled line of division start higher on the field than where the top portion ends, using a very specific rendition of the per bend sinister bevilled.
