


**Lasairfhíona inghean Gearailt Maigh Laithimh.** Name. The name was submitted to Laurel as Lasairfhíona inghean Gearailt  $\underline{o}$  Maigh Laithimh. However, the Laurel staff ruled that the phrase  $\overline{o}$  Maigh Laithimh appeared to be a descriptive phrase describing one or more persons, but not actually part of a personal name. they therefore have dropped the  $\overline{o}$  to change the name to Lasairfhíona inghean Gearailt\_Maigh Laithimh.

**Meadhbh the Handy.** Name and device. Gules, a hand within a bordure argent.



**Miriel de Nedham.** Device. Vert, a tree blasted and eradicated between three mullets of eight points argent.



**Osric the Pale.** Name and device. Vert, a pale wavy between two domestic cats combatant argent. In registering the device, the Laurel staff requested that the waves on the pale be drawn more deeply.

Osric the Pale. Badge. (Fieldless) An anvil pean.


**Rivka Sycheva.** Device. Gules, an arrow inverted and winged within a bordure embattled argent.


**Robert de Bardoulf.** Badge. Erminois, on a wolf's head erased gules a cleaver palewise reversed argent.


Tirloch of Tallaght. Alternate persona name for Mang von Ornbau.

## RETURNS

The following items were RETURNED by the Laurel Office:


**Iain Cinnsealach.** Change of device. Per pale azure and vert, a singlearched bridge argent. Ruling that a dolmen is no different from a bridge for purposes of conflict, the Laurel staff held this to be in conflict with the badge of Cadwalladyr Stone of Stonecroft ("Vert, a dolmen of three uprights capped by two lintels argent.") They also ruled that it conflicted with the badge registered to Clare RosMuire St. John for Stonebridge Freehold( "(Fieldless) On a fountain, a bridge of five arches, ends couped, argent.") as they held Clare's badge must be considered for conflict as if it were actually "Barry wavy azure and argent, a bridge of five arches argent."


**Isabel de Nedham.** Device. Azure, an otter statant between two triquetras argent. Ruling that the triquetras were too close size to the otter to be considered secondary charges so that all the charges were in a single charge group, the Laurel staff returned this for conflict with Ranald de Balinhard ("Azure, in pale three ferrets courant argent.") holding that there was only one difference for change to half the charge group.


**Rakel Kyrre.** Name. By Laurel precedent descriptive bynames in Old Norse may not be capitalized. Since the submitter did not allow any changes whatsoever to the name, the initial letter of the byname could not be changed to lower case. Although Rakel's mundane mother has the registered name *Sunniva Kyrre* and so she could normally invoke the "Grandfather Clause" for the use of the byname, the Laurel staff returned the name for lack of documentary proof of the relationship such as a birth certificate or letter from the submitter's mother attesting to the relationship.

**Turgeis Hakonsson and Sunniva Kyrre.** Badge. Azure, in saltire four triquetras Or, points to center, within an annulet argent. The Laurel staff returned the badge for redrawing because they felt that the triquetras had been distorted too greatly in an effort to make the badge resemble the design on a Celtic brooch, commenting that the triquetras "should be drawn in a 'Y' shape, not a 'T' shape."

**Turgeis Hakonsson and Sunniva Kyrre.** Badge. Azure, in saltire four triquetras argent, points to center, within an annulet Or.
