
Unto the populace of Atlantia, greetings from Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, Golden Dolphin Herald!

Herein you will find the results of the deliberations of the College of Heralds of Atlantia during the month of March, 2007.


ACCEPTANCES

The following submissions have been accepted and included on a Letter of Intent to the College of Arms from Atlantia dated 27 March, 2007:

Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge. (Fieldless) On an escallop Or a rose azure. This badge is intended for Atlantia's Queen's Order of Courtesy. We believe that current practice would consider the Queen's Order of Courtesy a generic identifier rather than something to be registered.




Atlantia, Kingdom of. Association of order name and badge. Argent, a billet between two unicornate natural seahorses azure. The name Académie d'Espée was registered in October, 1993 with a badge of "Or, two rapiers crossed in saltire sable between four roses azure." In November, 2000, only the badge was transferred to Nathaniel Sharpe. Meanwhile Atlantia had registered another badge ("Argent, a billet between two unicornate natural seahorses azure.") and for some years has been using that badge for the Académie d'Espée. This action associates the registered name and registered badge.



Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge for the Award of the Alcyon. (Fieldless) A kingfisher volant, wings elevated and addorsed, sustaining an escallop azure.



Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge for the Award of the Fountain. Argent, goutty, a bordure wavy azure.



Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge for the Order of the Sea Dragon. (Fieldless) A sea dragon per fess azure and argent.



Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge for the Award of the Sea Tyger. (Fieldless) A sea tyger per fess azure and Or.




Atlantia, Kingdom of. Badge for the Award of the Silver Osprey. (Fieldless) A sword palewise Or between and sustained by two ospreys rising combatant argent.




Crestienne Chabrier. Device. Azure, a dragon's head erased Or and on a chief invected argent, three spools vert. The submitter has provided the documentation necessary to prove that these spools occur in period.

Erik Olafssen. Name (see PENDS for device).



Gwyneth MacDonagh. Device. Per pale wavy Or and purpure, a greyhound courant contourny counterchanged.


Khadir bar Yosef ha-Kuzari. Change of name from Muirghen Ruadh.



Líadan ingen Fháeláin. Name (see PENDS for device). The name was originally submitted as Líadan ingen Faoláin. The given name was documented from Ó Corráin and Maguire (*Irish Names*, *s. n. Líadan*) and we were able to find it clearly documented as the name of a poetess whose love poem in Old Irish speaking of her lover *Cuirithir* is often referred to as the "Cen áinius" from the first line of the poem (www.ucc.ie/celt/published/G400035/index.html). Thus the old Irish given name accords well with the particle *ingen*. However, O'Brien's "Index of Names in Irish Annals" at www.s-gabriel.org/names/mari/AnnalsIndex/Masculine/Faelan.shtml indicates that *Faoláin* is an early modern genitive form rather than the old Irish or middle Irish genitive form *Fáeláin* that one would expect given the apparently earlier date of the remainder of the name. Since the submitter allowed all changes to her name, we have therefore modified the patronym to the older form to make the patronymic phrase linguistically consistent.


Marinus, Barony of. Guild name and badge for Scriptorium Marini. Per pale vert and azure, an open scroll and on a chief argent a quill pen fesswise sable.

Morgant Capellanus. Name (see PENDS for device).




Phillip of Ghent. Change of device. Per chevron argent and vert, two fir trees eradicated vert, each charged with a coronet, and a hawk striking argent.

Stierbach, Barony of. Order name for the Award of Saint Roch.




Tessa de Spina. Name and device. Per saltire azure and vert, a saltire and in chief a dragonfly argent.

Thomas of Chester. Name (see RETURNS for device).




William of Wolverhampton. Device. Sable, on a chief embattled Or three arrows fesswise gules.

The following submissions have been returned for further work:

Thomas of Chester. Device. Azure, on a chief Or three gouttes de sang. Unfortunately, this must be returned for conflict with Bjarni Eðvarðarson í Jórvík ("Azure, on a chief Or two ravens sable.") There is only one difference for the cumulative changes to the charges on the chief.




PENDS

The following submissions have been pended for the stated reasons:


Atlantia, Kingdom of. New order name and badge for the Award of the Golden Lance of Atlantia. (Fieldless) A seahorse azure sustaining a tilting lance palewise Or. This has been pended to allow the Crown to determine whether it is appropriate for Atlantia to meet the treaty requirements set by Ansteorra for granting permission to use the name Award of the Golden Lance.




Brian Cullen of Ormond. Name and device. Or, a chevron embattled vert between three cups gules. The forms stated that the name is new, but the device was returned in November, 1999, from the Middle Kingdom but there is no reason given and there is no record for the name. We have pended this submission because we have not yet heard back from the Middle clarifying the status of the name and the reason for return of the device.



Erik Olafssen. Device. Argent, a weeping willow sable charged on the trunk with an anchor argent, all within a bordure gules. This has been pended for redrawing to make the primary charge a more identifiable weeping willow.




John of Caer Gelynniog. Device. Sable, a raven and on a chief embattled argent, three arrows fesswise reversed gules. Since commenters had a great deal of difficulty in identifying the primary charge as a raven and only one foot was visible rather than the usual two, we have pended this for redrawing.




Kristin Ailbe Anmclaid. Badge. Or, a badger's head erased sable within a bordure gules. Since commenters had so much difficulty in identifying the primary charge as a badger's head, we have pended this badge to redraw it with an exact copy of the badger's head sable from her registered device, a form which is grandfathered to her.




Líadan ingen Fháeláin. Device. Or, a domestic cat sejant sable and on a chief wavy vert in dexter chief a bezant. Since most commenters had significant difficulty in identifying the cat as a cat and its posture as sejant, this has been pended for redrawing by Golden Dolphin staff.



Mærwynn de More. Device. Vert, on a bend sinister purpure, fimbriated, between a dragon couchant contourny and a harp, three roses argent. Since commenters still expressed concern with regard to the exact posture of the dragon, this has been pended for redrawing by Golden Dolphin staff.



Morgant Capellanus. Device. Per fess dovetailed gules and sable, in pale a castle and three Maltese crosses, two and one, argent. We have pended this to allow Golden Dolphin staff to redraw this with larger and deeper dovetailing as required by recent Laurel precedents.



Saint Georges, Canton of. Change of device. Argent, a stag's head erased gules within a laurel wreath vert, in base three barrulets wavy azure. We pended this because of technical issues with the required petition of support.
