






**Ceara níc Fhionnghalaigh.** Device. Or, a dragonfly and on a chief purpure three spools of thread Or.

Cairell mac Cormaicc. Change of name from Karcher the Blue-eyed.






**Elizabet de Roslyne.** Device. Sable, a mullet of eight points Or within a bordure argent mullety of eight points sable.




**Gunnora Swanburn.** Name and device. Argent, a pale offset between in bend sinister two swans naiant sable.




**Gwyneth of Avondale.** Device. Per chevron sable and Or, three decrescents one and two Or and a goblet sable.



**Henricus Guotman.** Name and device. Per fess wavy vert and purpure, in chief an ox yoke Or.




**Isabel de Nedham.** Resubmission of device. Per pale sable and azure, an otter between three triquetras argent.





**Isolda Jourdan.** Name and device. Per bend sinister azure and gules, a sun in splendor and a lion rampant guardant within a bordure Or.




**Juan Bautista Ponçe.** Device. Chevronelly Or and gules, an eagle sable and a base embattled vert.



**Katerina de Kelly.** Name and device. Per chevron sable and gules, two open scrolls addorsed Or and a money bag argent.






**Lyneya Allain.** Name and device. Purpure, on a cross within a bordure argent a cross of Calatrava purpure.






**Nuala ingen Magnusa.** Name and device. Sable, three oak leaves in pale within a bordure argent.


**Sebastiano Giovanni Casparo.** Device. Gules, a sealion erect Or sustaining a sword inverted proper within an orle of suns Or.



## **RETURNS**


The following items have been returned for further work:

**Fritz Justus Fritz.** Badge. (Fieldless) On a bezant a boar's head couped sable. By precedent, fieldess badges on a roundel have been disallowed as displays of armory for some time. All such badges must be considered for conflict as if that shape were a field of the same tincture so this must be returned for conflict with Hugo Maundivelle, the Improvident ("Quarterly Or and sable, in the first quarter a Boar's head couped sable, tusked and langued proper.") as well as the ensign of Tir Ysgithr ("Per fess azure and Or, in canton a bezant charged with a boar's head erased close reversed sable.").



**Matheu Herrerez de Cadiz.** Name. Unfortunately, although the commenters were able to provide documentation in the form of a period atlas with the spelling *Cadiz*, we were unable to find any evidence for the form *Herrerez* n the Laurel web page where it was stated to be found and the only instances of the name that we could find were modern. Roth's "16th Century Spanish Names" shows the locative *de Herrera* and the








patronymic Hernández at www.sca.org/heraldry/laurel/names/spanish. Two locative bynames would be

very unlikely in period Spanish and either of these options appear to be more than the very minor changes that he would allow.


Miriel de Nedham. Badge. (Fieldless) On a pomme a tree blasted and eradicated argent. By precedent, fieldess badges on a roundel have been disallowed as displays of armory for some time. All such badges must be considered for conflict as if that shape were a field of the same tincture so this must be returned for conflict with Wyndylyn Leanb na Doinneann ("Vert, a hurst of blasted birch trees argent."), Huette Aliza von und zu Ährens und Mechthildberg ("Vert, a tree blasted throughout Or.") and the the Order of the Silver Oak registered to the Middle ("Purpure, an oak tree blasted eradicated argent, fructed Or.")








**Vladimir Krisa Tirgovishtets.** Device. Quarterly sable and azure, a rat argent. There was almost unanimous agreement among the commenters that the rat was not in any known heraldic posture and that the emblazon could not be reconstructed from the blazon as required by the Society's rules. We could not resolve the situation by simply redrawing the rat in a more standard centered statant position because it would then conflict with Ellyn Heath of Hemingford Grey ("Azure, a rat statant argent.")




## **PENDS**

The following items have been pended for the stated reasons:

**Acelina le Dragon.** Device. Quarterly argent and Or, a dragon segreant and in base two demi-eagles, heads respectant, vert. Given the concerns of a number of commenters with regard to the identifiability of the demi-eagles, this has been pended for redrawing by Golden Dolphin staff.



**Isabetta del Gatta.** Device. Gules, a goblet Or within a bordure Or, semy of quatrefoils gules. The device has been pended for redrawing by Golden Dolphin staff with a more standard depiction of a bordure strewn with quatrefoils and a cup more centered on the field.



**Larisa Mikhailovna.** Device. Per chevron argent and azure, two estoiles azure and issuant from base a phoenix argent issuant from flames Or. This has been pended to allow Golden Dolphin staff to redraw the line of division in a more sharply angled manner to meet the current standards of the College of Arms.
