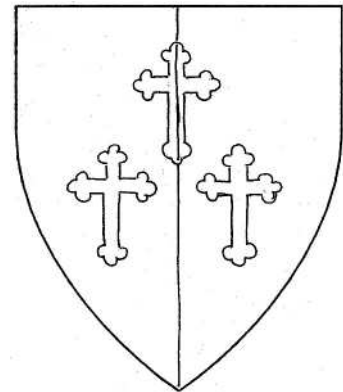
Unto the populace of Atlantia, greetings from Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, Golden Dolphin Herald!

Herein you will find the results of the deliberations of the College of Heraldry of Atlantia during the month of July, 2009.

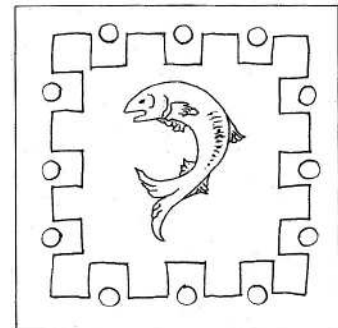
ACCEPTANCES

The following submissions have been accepted and included on a Letter of Intent to the College of Arms from Atlantia dated 24 July, 2009:

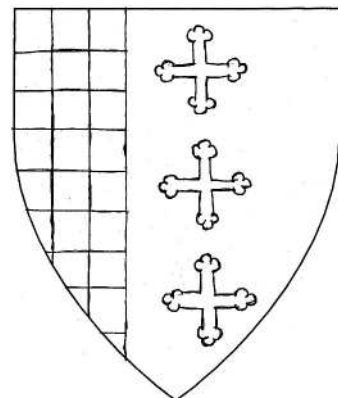
Alain de La Rochelle. Change of device. Per pale Or and sable, three Latin crosses bottonny one and two counterchanged.



Ceara ní Néill. Badge. Vert, a fish haurient embowed Or within a bordure embattled Or hurty.



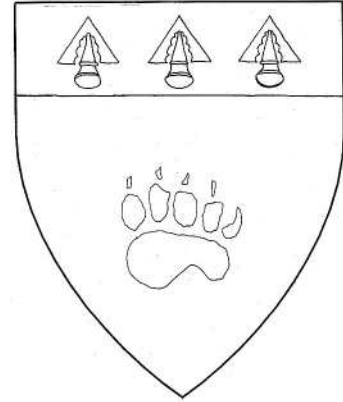
Elisabeth Hänslér. Change of device. Or, in pale three crosses bottonny sable, a dexter tierce checky purple and argent.



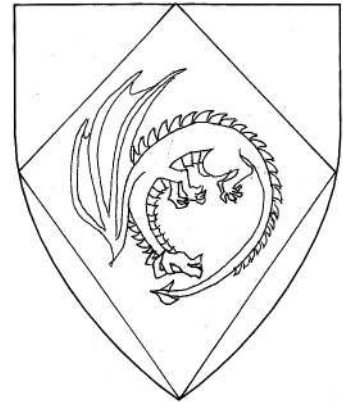
Janyn Fletcher of Lancastreschire. Device. Argent, a bear's pawprint sable and on a chief vert three pheons inverted argent.

Kunigunde von Darmstadt. Name.

Pippa Morosini. Change of name from Millicent Chandler.



Vilhjálmr spjótsbani. Device. Argent vetu gules, a dragon passant in annulo head to base purple.



RETURNS

The following items has been returned for further work:

Anne Cornelia Sintmaartensdijk. Change of name from Francesca Nicola Alessandra Cellini. We were able to find support for *Anna* as a Dutch given name and *Anne* as a German given name as well as for Cornelia in a Dutch and German context. However, no documentation was provided for the period use of a locative like this without a preposition such as *van*. Moreover, all period instances of the place name we could find make it two words: *Sint Maartensdijk*. Unfortunately, we had to return the name instead of modifying it to *Anna Cornelia van Sint Maartensdijk* because the submitter allowed only minor changes and the addition of the preposition is technically a major change.
