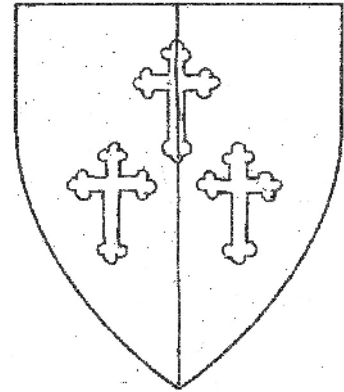
Unto the populace of Atlantia, greetings from Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, Golden Dolphin Herald!

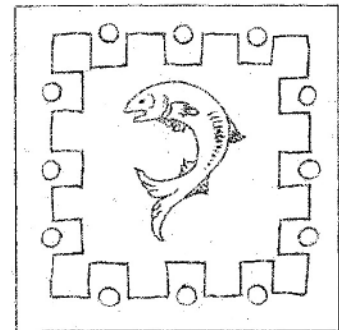
ACCEPTANCES:

The following items were REGISTERED by the Laurel Office:

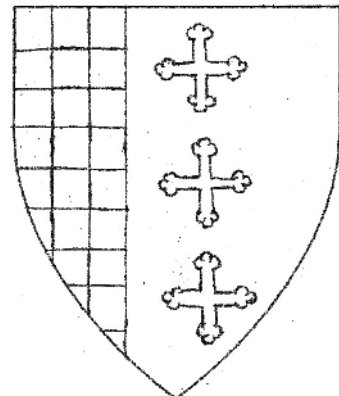
Alain de La Rochelle. Change of device. Per pale Or and sable, three Latin crosses bottonny one and two counterchanged.



Ceara ní Néill. Badge. Vert, a fish haurient embowed Or within a bordure embattled Or hurty.



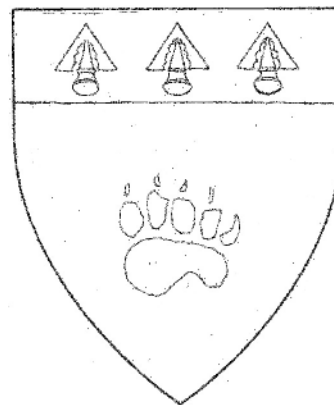
Elisabeth Hänsler. Change of device. Or, in pale three crosses bottonny sable, a dexter tierce checky purpure and argent.
