


Per bend wavy azure and Or, a drakkar and an annulet interlaced with a triquetra inverted counterchanged.

Barita Celeria - New Name & New Device


Vert, a closed book palewise with spine to dexter and on a chief argent three cats courant contourny sable.

Per chevron azure mulletty argent and argent, in base a drop spindle azure.




The use of a modern drop spindle is noted as a step from period practise.

Vert, an elephant's head coupé close and on a bordure Or three ermine spots sable.




Elena Margarida de la Vega y Serrano - New Name

Argent, a bear statant sable and a tierce gules ermined argent.



(Fieldless) On a seeblatt Or, a lion's head erased contourny sable.





Azure, a Russian firebird rising paly wavy Or and gules, within a bordure argent charged with eight cornflowers slipped and leaved proper.




This is a resubmission following the June, 2013 Atlantian return of *Azure, a Russian firebird rising Or within a bordure argent charged with eight cornflowers proper* so the cornflowers can be presented fully facing us rather than in a trian aspect."

Or, on a bend purple between a wheel of cheese and a squirrel sable, three pheons palewise Or.



This is a resubmission as both the name and device were returned by Atlantia in October 2012 as the name submitted (Cameron de Grey) could not be supported by documentation.

Sajah bint Habushun ibn Ishandiyar al-Hajjaji - New Release of Device

Per chevron vert and argent, three crosses fleury argent and a brown hippopotamus statant guardant proper


Tolir Hiorsson - New Name

Originally submitted as "Tólrir Hjorrson", the spelling of the given name and patronym was changed to a correct form which was approved by the submitter via a phone conversation with Golden Dolphin at 5:09 on July 11, 2013.

Vincenzo d'Este - New Name & New Device

Azure, a bat-winged man displayed and on a chief argent a double-headed eagle sable.



A bat-winged human has not been registered since the 80's, but should fit under A.2.B.2.c "Constructed Monsters".

Wanda Ostojowna - Resub Device

Per chevron engrailed gules and azure, two needles inverted and a mermaid face to sinister drawing a bow aimed to sinister chief argent




This is a resubmission after the Laurel return in September 2012 of Per fess engrailed gules and azure, a mermaid face to sinister drawing a bow and arrow aimed to sinister chief argent. It was returned for conflict with the badge of Morgan Alanna Morcheartaigh, *Per fess azure and sable, a auburn-haired mermaid proper, tailed argent, maintaining in her dexter hand a plate and in her sinister a sword bendwise sinister proper.*

Æpelswiþ of Sanderstede - New Device (see ACCEPTANCES for Name)

Sable, a chevron ermine between three horse heads erased argent.




This is being returned due to conflict with Una the Bashful's device registered in July of 2000 (via AEthelmearc): *Sable, a chevron ermine between three Catherine's wheels argent.* There is only one distinct change for the type of secondary charge. A few possible ways to resolve the conflict would be to cotise the chevron, or charge the chevron with one or three charges, or add a bordure... or contact Una to ask for permission to conflict.

Consulting Herald: Maaline Renard

Corwyn ap Lear - New Name & New Device

Vert, on flaunches wavy Or four swans respectant naiant sable.





This is being returned as the name construction cannot be supported by documentation. While instances of “Corwyn” and of “Lear” can be found in 16th century English as surnames and would be useable as a surname-turned-personal –name + surname, it would have to be without “ap”, which the submitter does not wish to forego.

As the name cannot be passed on to Laurel for registration, neither can the device. But besides that, between the use of "ap" in the name, and the device being strongly suggestive towards the major Welsh story "Children of Lir", this may be presumptive. Concern was also expressed about the flaunches being too wide to be accepted - understandably for the need to fit the swans in but probably too wide to have been registerable.

Dorothea Manuela Ponçe - New Device Change

Per bend sinister Or and vert, a gilly-flower proper and a tower Or




Consulting Herald: Lochlainn hua Rigbarddain, Raven's Cove Pursuivant

This is being returned for redrawing. The gillyflower & tower together form the primary charge group and should share a common posture/orientation. In this case, the flower seems bendwise sinister and the tower is palewise which breaks unity of posture/orientation.

Genevieve Dompier du Marche - New Device

Azure, a sun in splendor and on a chief Or three popinjays proper.



Hjorr Guðmundsson - New Device


Per bend azure and argent, in sinister chief three annulets interlaced Or and a sword gules.



This is being returned for a redrawing so the annulets can be interlaced and the sword drawn larger.

Pepin de Bourgogne - New Device (see "Acceptances for name)

Per chevron sable and gules, a chevron between three greyhounds courant two and one Or.

This is being returned for conflict with the device of Mael Duin Dubh mac Diarmada, *Per chevron sable and gules, a chevron between three mullets Or*, registered Aug 2008 via Trimaris. The submitting herald has already contacted the client and a new device, *Per chevron sable and gules on a chevron between three greyhounds courant two and one Or, three fleurs-de-lys sable* is on the Atlantian LoP dated 2013-07-08.
