Ibis has been receiving name submissions without the documentation properly summarized, Name submissions require the documentation to be summarized on the name documentation form. Attaching copies of the documentation isn't sufficient summarization. Proper summarization includes the following; name of the source, author of the source, web page if necessary and quick summary of the documentation.

Here is a couple examples of properly summarized documentation.

Duklyng: is found in the "A Dictionary of English Surname" by Reany and Wilson. Header name Duckling, John Duklyng 1483.

Elyzabeth: is found in "Feminine Given Names in A Dictionary of English Surnames" by Talan Gwynek, Fause Losenge Herald Extraordinary

<https://www.s-gabriel.org/names/talan/reaney/reaney.cgi?Elizabeth>. Elyzabeth is a female give name dated to 1524 Lavender; 1566 Sutcliff.

Brewer: is found in Family Search Historical Records

Amandus Brewer, male, christened on 15 Jun 1644 in Rhinland, Prussia, Batch #J95542-1
