

# **A Letter from Triton**


Unto the dedicated members of the Atlantian College of Heralds, greetings from Triton on this wet and wintery eve!

**Atlantia, Kingdom of.** Transfer of heraldic title Silver Hare Herald to Eógan Mac Ailpein.

**Atlantia, Kingdom of.** Transfer of heraldic title Rastrillo Herald to Isabella Benalcázar.

Caitilin has permission to conflict with the device of Santiago Ramirez de Calatrava, Lozengy vert and Or, a panther rampant argent spotted of divers tinctures incensed azure and maintaining a Latin cross fitchy gules.

**Conall mac Aodha mhic Réamoinn.** Name and device. Sable, a bend gules fimbriated and in chief a phoenix argent.

**Cynewulf atten Hyrste.** Reblazon of device. Or, two lions combatant, each sustaining a pennoncelle, poles crossed in saltire, within a bordure embattled sable.

Eiríkr úlfr Þorisson. Name.

**Eógan Mac Ailpein.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Silver Hare Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

**Étaín ingen Thadgáin.** Alternate name Eydís Herjólfsdóttir.

**Evan da Collaureo.** Augmentation. Per fess gules and sable, on a mountain of three peaks couped Or a sackbut fesswise, bell to sinister sable, for augmentation in canton a portcullis Or.

**Evan da Collaureo.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Sackbut Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

**Fríða in hárfagra.** Device. Gules, a linden tree eradicated and on a chief wavy argent three dragonflies bendwise sable.

**Giacinta of Highland Foorde.** Device. Per fess argent and azure, a sprig of harebells azure slipped and leaved vert and a compass star argent.

**Gorm of Berra.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Blue Pike Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

**Hannus Siltanen.** Name and device. Per pale gules and vert, a stag trippant and on a chief argent three Bowen knots vert.

**Ilaria de Gandia.** Name and device. Vert, a rapier and on a chief Or a threaded needle reversed gules.

**Isabele de Torriden.** Device. Argent chaussé purpure, three thistle heads proper and a chief purpure.

**Isabella Benalcázar.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Rastrillo Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

Ivarr Thorgislsson. Device change. Azure, a chevron rompu between two dragons displayed respectant and a caltrap argent. Ivarr has permission to conflict with Darius Cordell, Azure, a chevron rompu between three Bourchier knots palewise argent. His previous device, Per chevron argent and azure, two mallard drakes rising respectant proper and a double bitted axe argent, is retained as a badge.

**James de Biblesworth.** Device. Per pale azure and gules all crusilly Latin pomelly argent.

Jamila al-`Aquliyya. Name.

**Kieran Hunter.** Household name House of the Hounds.

**Matheu de Torriden.** Name and device. Per pale Or and azure, a cross formy counterchanged and a chief checky argent and sable.

**Minowara Kiritsubo.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Draic Derg Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

Despite Minowara Kiritsubo's untimely death (mentioned in the February 2011 Cover Letter), the request was properly formed and the action taken (though not published) while she was still alive. As neither the kingdom nor her heirs have requested that this be withdrawn, the transfer proceeds as any other action. Our thoughts are with her family.

**Temair ingen Fháelchon meic Domnaill.** Badge. Per chevron vert and azure, a sea-wolf and in canton a compass star argent.

Thamira ha Sopheret. Name.

**Tirloch of Tallaght.** Heraldic title Albus Ursus Herald.

**Tómas Tryggvason.** Device. Gyronny arrondy of six azure and argent, on a bordure sable three plates.

Veronica d'Angelo da Lucca. Name.

Wiglaf Sigeberhting. Name.

Windmasters' Hill, Barony of. Order name Award of the Hurt and badge association. (Fieldless) An annulet argent hurty. The submitters have permission to conflict with the *Order of the Hart*, registered to the Barony of Highland Foorde. The badge was registered in November 2007, via Atlantia.

**Yngvildr Galtadóttir.** Device. Per bend sinister sable and purpure, a boar rampant Or and a chief embattled erminois.

**Greenlion Bay, Canton of.** Branch name and device. Argent, a sea-lion vert within a laurel wreath azure, a bordure embattled vert.

**Helga Gunnarsdóttir.** Name and device. Quarterly argent and sable, in saltire five mullets of eight points counterchanged.

**Highland Foorde, Barony of.** Order name Order of the Quoyne and badge. Sable masoned argent, a ford proper.

**Highland Foorde, Barony of.** Badge. Gules, a ford proper.

**Nadezhda Faeva.** Name and device. Per bend sinister sable and purpure, a decrescent argent and a wagon wheel Or.

**Niese Keppel.** Device. Quarterly argent and purpure, two roses purpure barbed and seeded proper within a bordure embattled counterchanged.

**Pedro de Alcazar.** Acceptance of transfer of heraldic title Padrão Herald from Atlantia, Kingdom of.

**Sara van Eerde.** Device. Per pall argent, azure and vert, a bear sejant erect Or maintaining a rose slipped and leaved proper, a chief sable.

Scribonia Sabina Mus. Name.

**Stiamna mac Martain.** Name and device. Vert, four wood chisels bendwise sinister blades to chief two and two Or.

**Thamira ha Sopheret.** Device. Azure, an open book and on a mount argent a mullet of six points azure.

**Theresa O Cahir.** Name and device. Azure, in pale three bees between flaunches argent.

**Thomas Longshanks.** Badge. (Fieldless) In pale a demi fleur-de-lys issuant from a mount couped gules.

**Úlfgeirr Hrafnsson.** Name and device. Argent, a wolf rampant sustaining a poleaxe between in chief two ravens rising azure wings elevated and addorsed.

**Wiglaf Sigeberhting.** Device. Azure platy, a cross formy nowy gules fimbriated Or.

William Gillecrist Ross. Name and device. Argent, a bend between a bird close gules and two rapiers in saltire sable.

**Eiríkr úlfr Porisson.** Device. Argent, a sea-wolf erect contourny sable and in chief two flames each per pale gules and Or and charged with a Thor's hammer sable. This device was withdrawn by the submitter.

**Domnall mac Arcill.** Name and device. Per bend azure and argent, a moon in her plenitude and a crab counterchanged.

**Eduard de Witte.** Name and device. Azure, three sheaves of arrows one and two Or.

**Eiríkr úlfr Þorisson.** Device. Argent, a sea-wolf erect contourny sable and in chief two Thor's hammers sable enflamed proper.

**Fríða in hárfagra.** Alternate name Frida von Feldkirchen.

**Jacintha of Highland Foorde.** Name reconsideration from Giacinta of Highland Foorde.

Jaume de Monçó. Name.

**Roland Wodeman.** Name and device. Argent, in pale two turtles between flaunches vert.

**Timothy Barfoot.** Name and device. Per fess azure and sable, a fess wavy between an arrow fesswise and a hand argent.

**Raven's Cove, Barony of.** Order name Award of the Sun Stone. The submitters failed to demonstrate that *Sun Stone* follows a pattern for an award name. However, the submission also conflicts with the Kingdom of Ansteorra's *Gunstone Pursuivant*.

**Raven's Cove, Barony of.** Order name Order of the Dirk. This name is returned for conflict with the registered name *The Dark Horde*.

**Dreux d'Anjou.** Name and device. Azure, on an ermine spot argent two annulets interlaced in fess azure.

**Dýrfinna Freviðardóttir.** Device. Azure, a tree blasted and eradicated in canton a mullet all between flaunches argent.

**Emma West.** Badge. (Fieldless) On a water bouget Or, two oak leaves vert.

**Estienne Le Mons d'Anjou.** Name. *Le Mons* is the submitter's legal surname.

**Isemay the Nimble.** Name.

Jana de Foresta. Name.

Laura Graley de la Moore. Name.

**Patrick of Kells.** Name change from Ardgal Ó Faoláin. His previous name, *Ardgal Ó Faoláin*, is retained as an alternate name.

**Sybyle of Somerset.** Name and device. Or, on a fess between two drop spindles and a pig-snouted psaltery inverted vert, a unicorn couchant to sinister argent.

**Tailefhlaith ingen Ruaircc.** Device. Purpure, two estoiles in fess Or and a ford proper.

**William Milo de Nedham.** Name and device. Per pale sable and azure, a bear rampant between three triquetras argent.

William of Scarborough. Name.

Ysoria of Scarborough. Name.

### **RETURNS**

**Domenico Barbiere da Mantova.** Badge. Argent, semy of fireballs proper, a chevron raguly gules. This badge is being returned for redraw.

# Point of Fact

Dimidiation, to indicate the marriage of two nobles, is a curious heraldic practice that was used for barely a century, starting in the late 1200s. In dimidiation, the husband's and wife's shields would be chopped in half, usually palewise, and the dexter half of one spouse's device would be affixed to the sinister half of the other's. This could result in some strange-looking animals. For example, the partially dimidiated arms of the town of Hastings (right), an attempt to depict an alliance in heraldry, contain two lions with ships for tails. In SCA heraldry, dimidiation is not allowed because it is a form of marshaling, and often a rather ugly one that produces hard-to-recognize charges. At least one household in An Tir, though, uses a non-registered device that is basically a sun dimidiated with a green gremlin's head.



Heraldry is an art as old as Henry II and Eleanor of Aquitaine, and as young as the newest submission.
